What is a Swish?

There will be a temporary changing area set up for you to try on clothes and ensure a good fit.

We are also hoping to have a seamstress at the event who will be able to make simple repairs to clothes that you wish to keep in action. **If you know of anybody who is handy with a sewing machine and available between 10-12 on 17th March please let me know.**
