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## After-school Sports

There are a wide variety of after-school clubs available and these can change depending on interest and support available. This year we have offered:

### Football Club

This club meets on Saturday mornings. It is organised by our parents and is open to boys and girls from P.4.

### Gymnastics Club

The gymnastics club is held from October – March with a gymnastics festival taking place in January. It is held on Monday after-school.

### Basketball & Netball
