Who can take part?

The summer course is open to any child aged 9-15, who plays an orchestral or wind band instrument at grade 2 to grade 8 level and beyond. There are no auditions.

What will they play?

Participants will spend most of their time with one of three ensembles. More advanced players will join the **Symphony Orchestra**, conducted by Matthew Rowe. Younger players will join the **Junior String Orchestra**, conducted by Joanna Petrie, or the **Wind Band**, conducted by Susan Dingle. There are also opportunities for musicians of all ages to play together. Check out our website for a taste of the classical masterpieces, popular favourites and lesser-known treats played by our ensembles.

What is the timetable like?

Our timetables are varied, but will always include a mix of sectional rehearsals, ensemble rehearsals, sport or art sessions and an evening entertainment – ranging from concerts to ceilidhs and beyond! There is an open day on the Thursday of the course when parents and siblings will be invited to visit their children and see the course in progress.

When are the final concerts?

The course will end with celebration concerts at 2.45pm and 4.45pm on Saturday 20 July at Carnegie Hall in Dunfermline.

What does it cost?
